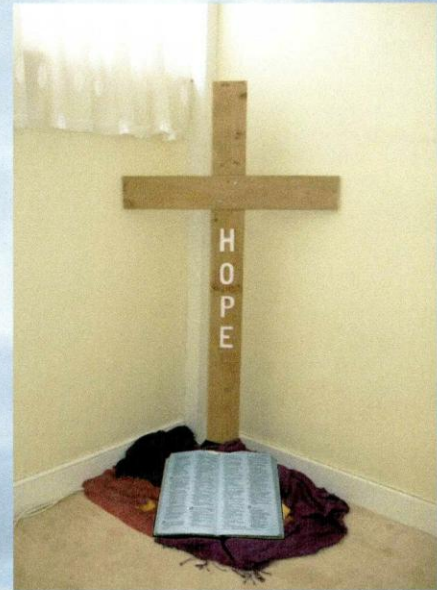

Bethel Hastings & St Leonards Prayer Rooms



"Pray without ceasing"
(1 Thess. 5 v 17)

"Bethel" Hastings and St Leonards Prayer Rooms

"Bethel" was opened by the Mayor of Hastings on 5th September 2008. "Bethel" is situated on the lower floor of Wellington Square Church right in the town centre of Hastings almost directly opposite the Town Hall, Council Chambers and surrounded by shops and businesses.

Occupying two rooms it has a small entrance lobby with independent outside access through a keypad door directly on to Albert Road.

Prior to moving to this location "Hastings 24/7 Prayer" met in other locations in the town including rooms made available by local businesses and churches. In 2008 Wellington Square Church kindly gave full use of the current premises for 24/7 prayer by churches and Christians across the town.



What is 24/7 Prayer?

24/7 Prayer is simply a modern term describing the call for Christians everywhere to make prayer a priority, obeying the Bible's command to "pray unceasingly". In recent years this has become a worldwide phenomenon sweeping the churches of the 21st century and taking place in cathedrals, night clubs, churches and a multitude of what have become known as "prayer houses" of every description.



The praying itself illustrates the huge diversity and variety to be found in God's Church.

Very often the praying does not stop there but goes on to express itself not just in a renewed passion and love for God but through a multitude of practical expressions of God's love for His world.

How can I use "Bethel"?

While we can pray in our own homes, or in a multitude of other places, "Bethel" provides a designated place where Christians can come and pray, either individually or with others, and in whatever way they find comfortable and helpful.

The "Contemplative Room" provides a place for quieter prayer. Visitors are requested to remove their shoes, and also in other ways to respect that this room is particularly given over to God in worship and reverence.



The "Creative Room" allows for a wider expression of prayer, including the provision of paints and drawing materials. Both rooms contain helpful resources for prayer.

24 hour a day access can be given through requesting a simple form from "Hastings 24/7 Prayer". The prayer rooms are in use at all times, including lunchtimes, evenings and for nights of prayer.
